February Beekeeping Notes— written by Pat Allen

This month can be very cold and wet. If you think your bees may be running short of stores then you can give them some fondant, but don't open them up any more than that.

Remove mouseguards by the end of February as these tend to knock the vital pollen off the bees' legs.

Check the varroa drop by inserting a greased board below the mesh floor and leaving it for a week. Count the varroa and divide by the number of days the insert was in. If there are more than 5/day, then use a varroa treatment (e.g. one tray of Apiguard) at the end of February or early March.

Is your spare equipment ready? You'll need it soon.
